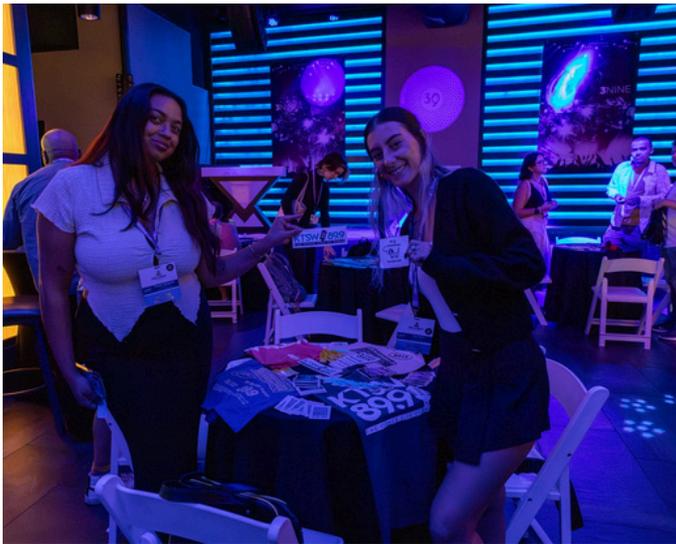
EVENT SPONSORS

CAREER FAIR PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY: College Broadcasters, Inc. reserves the right to determine the eligibility of each Company for this Career Fair event and further reserves the right to reject any application and/or limit space assigned to any one company without explanation. Career Fair Companies will receive special featured status at an informal meet-and-greet event on Friday afternoon and adequate space for follow-up appointments on Saturday morning with individual student attendees.

INTERNET AND ELECTRICAL POWER: All arrangements for wired internet and major electrical power requirements must be made directly with the Embassy Suites Downtown Denver Hotel. College Broadcasters, Inc. assumes no responsibility for expenses incurred for electrical, internet or other utility hookups and usage on the exhibition floor or elsewhere in the hotel. When possible, College Broadcasters, Inc. provides wireless internet and basic wall outlet electricity for tables free of charge, but these complementary amenities are not guaranteed.

EXHIBITION SPACE AND BOOTH CONSTRUCTION: Exhibitors are renting an approximately 6 x 6 foot exhibition space. The exhibition booth fees provide exhibitors with a standard hotel rectangular table and two chairs, table draping, two conference registrations and two copies of the convention program.
